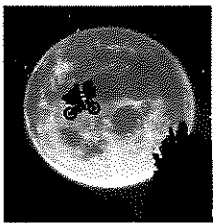


Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone – Film with the Orchestra

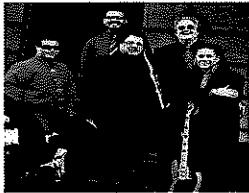
